- Demand safe MCAT testing conditions or MCAT optional admissions during the pandemic
- Offer premedical students a place to share their opinions and concerns without fear of retribution
- Create a culture of transparency where AAMC must give students clear and accessible information to make important decisions

WHY WE DO IT

Amidst the coronavirus pandemic and unprecedented civil unrest, SEA members recognized that premedical students lacked an official advocacy body. Because nearly all aspects of medical school admissions are controlled by a single 501c3 organization, we decided to create a group that could both speak out for premedical interests and advocate for greater transparency from the AAMC.
